I think lectures are pretty boring regardless, whether or not I understand the content. In this case, I understood all of the content until the last unit. I came to every single class and did very well, but I'd expect that someone who did well in STOR 155, 113, and likes data would do well in this course without having to come to class. Many people probably had an opposite experience than I did, so I don't want this to be a blanket statement for everyone. But I think that this class could be offered in an advanced format to people who did well in 155 and 113, so they could skip through the majority of the topics before the first exam, and then learn about the alternative models (last unit) as a longer lesson and add additional content. Again, some people probably had a hard time, but two options would be great!

#### Comments

Please give us more chances to practice materials taught in class and post the grades for the exams on time.

Although the material was interesting, I found class time to not be productive at all for myself and the majority of my classmates. The majority of class periods were spent working on STATA, which we cannot use on exams. The purpose behind devoting so much class time to the use of this program is unknown to me. In the earlier sections of the class when we did a significant amount of calculations, I believe it would be way more helpful for the professor to work out the problems by hand step by step. Simply having the process on the slides did not show how or why these numbers were determined and made it difficult to understand if I hadn't previously learned the material. Although I greatly appreciated the professor posting the slides online so I could follow along in class, I didn't gain anything from sitting in the class that I couldn't gain from looking at the slides independently, therefore I think there should be more in class information that will motivate students to go to class and understand the material to a higher level.
